






MSU Makes Literacy Packets

On October 17th, the MSU CKI Club held a meeting where members created literacy packets for preschoolers!


In total, MSU created and collected 20 literacy packets to be donated to Love Letters for Literacy!

Over 65 students attended their meeting and 9 blankets were donated in total!






MSU Goes Trick-or-Treating

They also held a <u>GoFundMe</u> that raised over \$150!




